WHEREAS, the Judges of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida and others, with the consent of the Chief Judge, have available to them the services of the Trial Courts Staff Attorney in the person of Brian D. Priester, Esquire; and


WHEREAS, the Staff Attorney requires access to all judicial records in order to carry out his duties;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff Attorney shall have access to all judicial records maintained in this Circuit and shall be permitted to receive any such records from any of the file rooms maintained by the Clerk of the Court.
2. The Staff Attorney shall return files to the Clerk of the Court as soon as his research is concluded or, if the file is forwarded to a judge, he shall note the date the file was forwarded, style and case number of the file, and to which judge the file was forwarded. At all times he shall maintain an inventory of files in his possession in the event this information is required by the Clerk of the Court.
3. The Staff Attorney shall immediately provide any file in his possession to the Clerk of Court upon request.
4. The Staff Attorney shall comply with all related policies and procedures of the Office of the Clerk of Court.

Administrative Order 2.046, dated February 8, 1999, is hereby rescinded.
